

Student Information Sheet: Jr/Sr All-District Band 2010 Information

Congratulations on your selection to the Junior or Senior All-District Band! We hope you have an exciting time at the clinic and remind you that behavior should be exemplary at all times. There will be approximately 400 students involved in this event.

Since we are in a conference center and hotel, students are only allowed in the convention area during rehearsals. Band members are only allowed in Cabaret Restaurant during meals or with a director/chaperone. Also, band students are not to be in their rooms during the day unless you are accompanied by your director/chaperone. There are restrooms located by your rehearsal area and food/trash is to be thrown away in the trash cans during breaks.

Students are expected to attend all rehearsals in their entirety in order to participate in the concert and to be eligible to audition for All-Virginia Band. If a student is tardy after a break or meal, he/she will move to bottom of the section. Students are also to have a pencil and necessary accessories (reeds, oil, mutes, sticks, mallets, pitch pipes) at all rehearsals.

Please make sure that all valuables are not left unattended at any time during the event. **The Holiday Inn Convention Center or host schools are not responsible for any lost items.**

Meals will not be provided at the Holiday Inn again this year. Students and directors will have to go to exit 5 or 7 to eat lunch. At exit 7, there is a Wendy's, Dairy Queen, Fazoli's, Taco Bell, Subway, McDonald's in Wal-Mart, and Bojangles. At exit 5 (5 minutes away), there is an Arby's, McDonald's, Kentucky Fried Chicken, Burger King, Hardees, and Long John Silvers.

Registration will be in the hall of the conference center. The cost of registration this year is \$26.00 per student. This fee covers all expenses related to the District Band event. Students are to wait in the Grand Ballroom while their director registers. Band cases and luggage can be stored in the Grand Ballroom or bus until check-in time. Students are also to wear their name tags at all times during the clinic. The concert will begin at 4 pm in the Grand Ballroom for the Jr. bands and at 6 PM for the Sr. bands. The concert order will be Junior Concert Band, Junior Symphonic Band, Senior Concert Band, and Senior Symphonic Band. All performances will be recorded by Magnetic Memories and can be pre-ordered at the concert for \$18.00. (checks can be made payable to Magnetic Memories)
